Accessibility for guests with mobility-related disabilities at the Home and Studio, Robie House and Bach House varies; the buildings are multi-level, and guests will need to navigate stairs and be able to stand for approximately 1 hour. Walkers are permitted in all venues, after passing an inspection to ensure no damage to doors. The Trust has walkers with a built-in seat available on a first-come, first-served basis. The majority of spaces in Unity Temple are accessible. The main level of the sanctuary is accessible with the use of a wheelchair stair lift.
